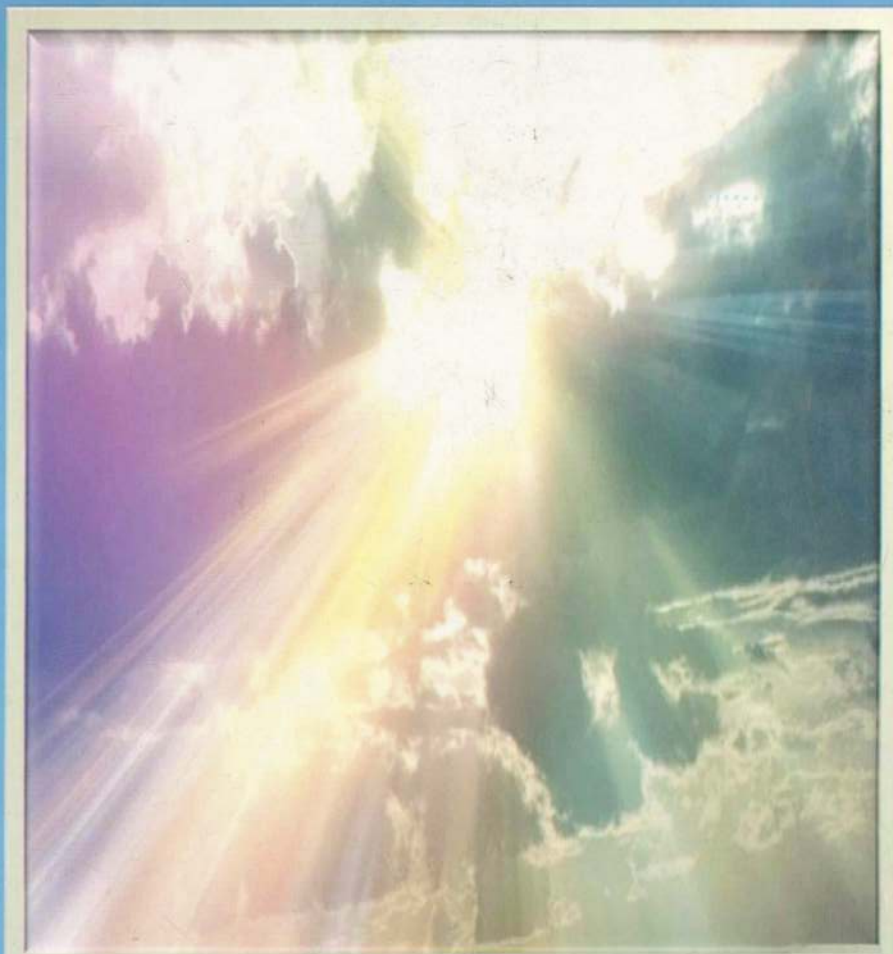
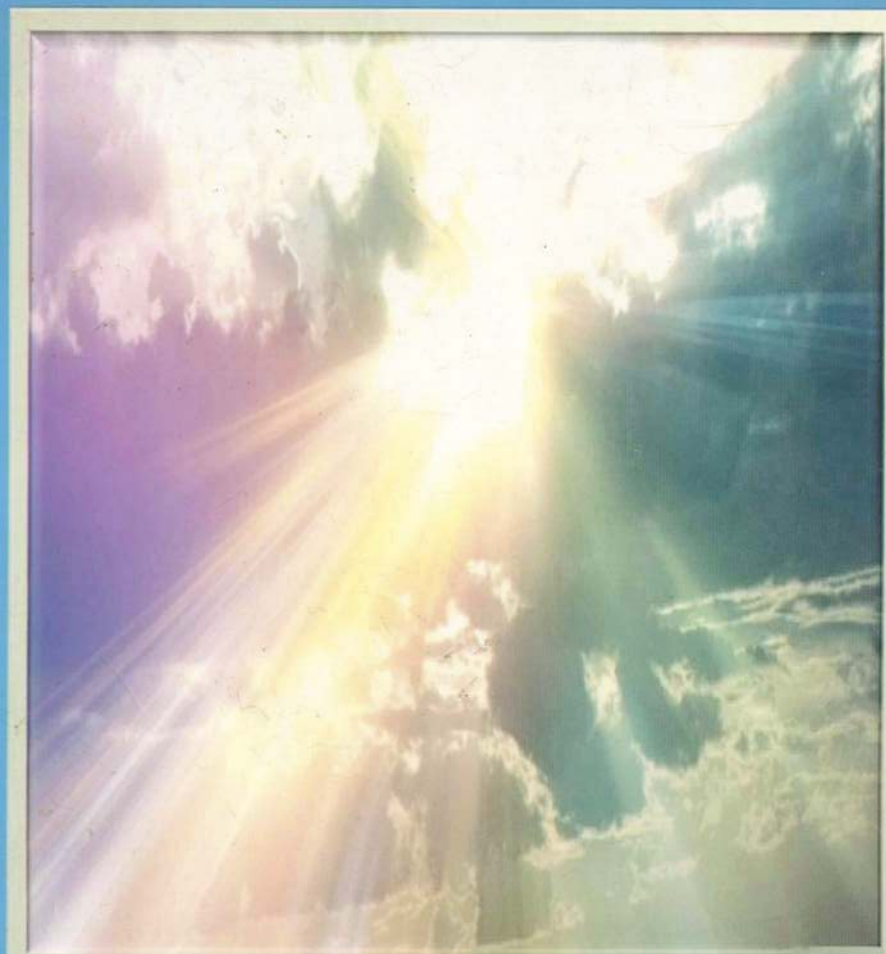

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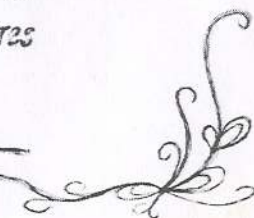

Casa Chapel Triangle

- * The triangle is the symbol of the Casa de Dom Inácio de Loyola
- * One of the oldest spiritual symbols found in many faiths and cultures
- * In the Main Hall of the Casa is a large wooden triangle mounted on the wall behind the stage
- * Many call it the "Healing Triangle" or "Sacred Triangle"
- * The three sides represent the three elements of Faith, Love and Charity
- * The upward pointing triangle is the connection into the higher levels
- * The triangle is said to hold the energy of the Entities
- * Visitors use the triangle as a spot to pray, make requests and connect with the Entities
- * Written prayers, photographs and requests can be placed inside the bottom portion of the triangle
- * Throughout the day, a volunteer collects them and gives them to Medium João
- * Many place their palms on the arms of the triangle while resting their head in the center
- * There have been remarkable healings and miracles from the triangle
- * Don't underestimate the triangle, it is very powerful!

Do Miracles Happen?

- * Yes! Absolutely. With God all things are possible.
- * Healing occurs first on the spiritual level, then on the mental and physical levels. Your whole being will receive healing.
- * A spiritual healing is ultimately the greatest gift of all.
- * Your miracle may not look exactly like you'd expect.
- * You don't always get what you want, you get what you need.
- * You may need to heal in other areas of your life first.
- * Healing may be instantaneous or through a series of shifts. For some it may require several visits.
- * Transformations may occur in layers as you are ready and able.
- * All healing, growth and evolution are an ongoing process that requires patience, perseverance, persistence and faith.
- * Healing may require changes to one's lifestyle and way of thinking. It may be necessary to shift your perspective on certain areas of your life.
- * You may need to evolve through a challenge rather than eradicate it.
- * The Entities cannot change things or intervene if it is your karma to experience something but they can assist you with love, support and guidance if asked.
- * Healing may occur at anytime and anywhere while at the Casa.
- * The Current is a powerful place for healing.
- * Healing is supported through the Blessed Water, Spiritual Soup, Herbal Prescriptions, and Crystal Light Beds.
- * The Casa Gardens and Sacred Waterfall also promote healing.
- * Miracles and healing can also occur by praying or placing photographs at the triangle.
- * Remember, all healing received at the Casa works in conjunction with traditional medicine. Physical doctors are also messengers of God.
- * Entities will do 50% of the work, you're responsible for the other 50%. It is a co-creation and partnership. You must make the effort.
- * The actual healing force is God's love...

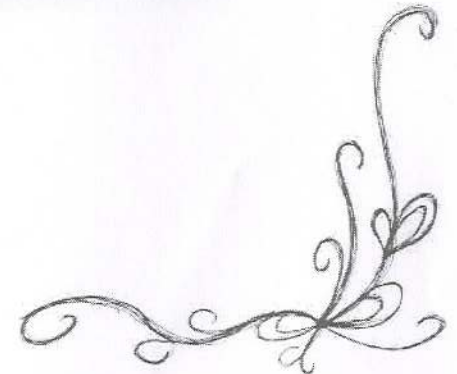

- * Blue Ray and Master of God's will
- * Member of the Great White Brotherhood ~ enlightened beings who oversee the development of the human race on this planet to higher levels of consciousness
- * Master of Energy through the throat chakra in the science of the spoken word
- * Chohan of the First Ray, Throat Chakra
- * He represents the Godly attributes of power, forthrightness, will, drive, courage, certainty, confidence, dependability, faith, self-reliance, initiative, power and strength. Works with rulers, executives, public servants, the military, commanders and sports people.
- * He teaches us that the will of God is within us. It is our inner blueprint, our inner calling, the design of the soul. To rebel against the will of God is to rebel against the Self, the True Self. He teaches us the way to know our life's purpose. Many desire to know their life's purpose, few desire to know that purpose within the context of the will of God. Life is not worth living when it is lived even for a moment outside of the will of God.
- * In the late nineteenth century, Master El Morya with Master Kuthumi was instrumental in the establishment of the Theosophical Society in 1875 through Helena P. Blavatsky to ensure that long lost truths resurface
- * Many believe that some of Master El Morya's previous incarnations include: Emperor of Atlantis, Abraham, Melchior (One of the Three Wise Men), King Arthur of Camelot, Thomas Becket (Archbishop of Canterbury), Thomas More (Chancellor of England), Akbar the Great (Mogul Emperor), Thomas Moore (Irish Poet), Shams Tabrizi (Rumi's teacher), El Morya Khan (Rajput Prince)
- * Keynote music to attune to Master El Morya: Pomp and Circumstance
- * Etheric Retreat Centers: The Temple of Goodwill (Darjeeling, India) and El Capitan (Yosemite Valley, California)

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Ascended Master St. Germain

- * Violet Ray and Master of Transmutation and Transformation
- * Member of the Great White Brotherhood ~ enlightened beings who oversee the development of the human race on this planet to higher levels of consciousness
- * Master Alchemist of the sacred re who comes bearing the gift of the Violet Flame of Freedom
- * Chohan of the Seventh Ray, Seat of the Soul Chakra
- * He represents the Godly attributes of freedom, alchemy, transmutation, sacred ritual, justice, mercy, dignity, poise, true statesmanship, and diplomacy. Works with all souls in the ritual of transmutation through the Violet Flame.
- * Known for his eternal youth and creation of the Elixir of Life. Associated with the color violet, the jewel amethyst and the Maltese Cross. Believed to have many magical powers such as the ability to teleport, levitate, walk through walls and inspire people by telepathy.
- * Sponsoring Master of the United States of America. Many credit him with inspiring the Founding Fathers to draft the US Declaration of Independence and The Constitution as well as inspiring the impressive design of the Great Seal of the United States.
- * Many believe that some of Master St. Germain's previous incarnations include: Christopher Columbus, Merlin the Magician, Leonardo DiVinci, Samuel the Prophet, St. Joseph, St. Alban, Hesiod, Prince Rakoczy, High Priest of the Violet Flame Temple of Atlantis, Roger Bacon and Francis Bacon (believed to have authored the complete plays attributed to Shakespeare)

- * Yellow Ray and Master of Illumination
- * Member of the Great White Brotherhood ~ enlightened beings who oversee the development of the human race on this planet to higher levels of consciousness
- * Master Psychologist who helps others become master psychologists of their own psyche or soul
- * Formerly Chohan of the Second Ray of Wisdom and now serves with Jesus in the Office of World Teacher
- * He represents the Godly attributes of wisdom, illumination, tact, foresight, consideration and friendliness. Works particularly with teachers, students, architects, ambassadors, poets and the artistic. He is very interested in all who are teaching the spiritual truths.
- * In the late nineteenth century, Master Kuthumi with Master El Morya was instrumental in the establishment of the Theosophical Society in 1875 through Helena P. Blavatsky to ensure that long lost truths resurface
- * Many believe that some of Master Kuthumi's previous incarnations include: Pythagoras (Greek Philosopher-Sacred Geometry), Pharaoh Thutmose III (Prophet and High Priest-Mysteries of Isis), Shah Jahan (Emperor of India and builder of the Taj Mahal), Balthazar (one of the Three Wise Men who came to pay homage to Baby Jesus), St. Francis of Assisi, John the Beloved, Johan Sebastian Bach (German Composer), and Koot Hoomi Lal Singh (Indian Kashmiri Prince) who attended Oxford University bringing Eastern understandings to the Western World
- * Keynote music to attune to Master Kuthumi: Kashmiri Song
- * Etheric Retreat Centers: Spiritual Retreat (Shigatse, Tibet) and the Temple of Illumination also known as The Cathedral of Nature (Srinagar, Kashmir)

Who are the Entities of Light?

- * João Teixeira de Faria (João de Deus) is the healer and medium known as John of God
- * With the grace of God's love, it is through him that the Entities of Light also called, "Entities" or "Spirit Doctors" are able to work and assist humanity in all forms of healing
- * He incorporates one Entity at a time which simply means, he allows Spirits of Light to enter and utilize his physical body for charitable reasons. A male medium incorporates male Entities and a female medium incorporates female Entities. While incorporating Entities he is called, "John of God." He is also referred to as, "Medium João."
- * During this process there may be many other energies (both male and female) helping out in the background and forefront as needed. There are over 30 different Entities that incorporate but possibly thousands more involved in the healing process.
- * Who are these Entities? They are extremely advanced and benevolent spirits of love and light who once lived on earth and choose to serve God and humanity through their work at the Casa. They do not need to reincarnate on the physical earth plane but continue to evolve on the spiritual plane by assisting humanity. They occasionally make their identity known but not always.
- * These incredible helpers are spirits of deceased physicians, surgeons, dentists, psychologists, therapists, pharmacists, nurses, scientists, theologians, philosophers, philanthropists, journalists, writers, saints, Jesuits, priests, nuns, missionaries, martyrs, spiritists, mediums, educators, politicians, knights, kings, leaders, notable figures, masters, etc...
- * Each have their own specialty and are able to understand the root cause of all our issues and how to heal them in accordance with our highest good
- * They scan a person's energy field to see what they need and recommend a variety of methods and procedures for healing to begin
- * They work with each person on all levels that are necessary: spiritual, mental and physical
- * Oftentimes, healing is based on the readiness of the soul
- * The Entities will literally start working on you the moment you decide to go to the Casa, during your journey, while you are there and even when you return home. They are with you for life if you so choose.
- * In addition, they also work with those who watch videos of John of God, read his story or show an interest in what is happening at the Casa
- * The Entities send their energy to all who ask for help
- * All Healing comes from God's love...

King Solomon (10th Century B.C.)



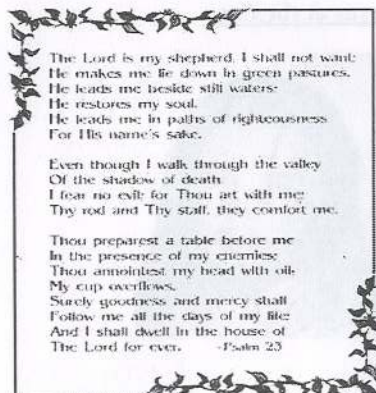
King Solomon

ONE of the most popular accounts of Solomon's wisdom describe two woman seeking his judgment over a dispute regarding a small child; each woman arguing that she was the rightful mother. King Solomon decreed he would cut the child in half. Upon hearing this ruling, the true birth mother relinquished her rights, begging Solomon not to harm the child. Upon hearing her words, Solomon presented the woman with the child.

1 Kings 3:16-28

- * King Solomon was the first Entity to incorporate in João Teixeira de Faria (when he was 16)
- * Son of King David and Bathsheba
- * His forty-year reign over the Israelites is recorded in I Kings and II Chronicles
- * Although he commanded a large army, he preferred negotiations to warfare; he was adept in keeping the peace and preventing war
- * His greatest accomplishment was the completion of the Holy Temple, a monument erected to preserve the Arc of the Covenant on Mount Mariah
- * The Temple represented a sacred sanctuary, where the Jewish people could freely commune with God in accordance with religious rituals and pilgrimages. The Temple was seen as a pinnacle of success based on religious, political and commercial criteria.
- * Solomon is attributed with having written the books of Proverbs and Ecclesiastes
- * Many secular stories remark on Solomon's wisdom and fairness as a ruler
- * Considered, "The wisest of all men"
- * When asked by God what he desired, he asked only for an understanding heart. God was so pleased with the request that He granted it, along with riches and power.
- * King Solomon (like his father, King David) is an extremely advanced spiritual Entity and therefore, only incorporates occasionally

King David (1040-970 BC)



- * Biblical King David of Israel (father to King Solomon and husband to Bathsheba)
- * The second king of the United Kingdom of Israel and Judah (Saul being the 1st)
- * In his 40 years as ruler (between 1010-970 BCE), he united the people of Israel, led them to victory in battle, conquered land and paved the way for his son, King Solomon to build the Holy Temple, which was erected to preserve the Arc of the Covenant
- * He is depicted as a righteous king, although not without faults, as well as an acclaimed warrior, musician (harpist) and poet, traditionally credited with composing many of the psalms contained in the Book of Psalms
- * David is an important figure to members of the Jewish, Christian and Islamic faiths. In Islam, he is considered a prophet.
- * Well known for picking seven smooth stones from a nearby brook and striking the Philistine giant, "Goliath" in the forehead with a stone from his sling. David credited God for delivering him from the hand of the Philistines and saving him from the "snares of death," in his psalm, David's Song of Praise found in 2 Samuel 22: "The Lord is my rock, my fortress and deliverer..."
- * Psalm 23 was also written by King David, who looked back on his life and could trace the hand of God moving in it at all times. "The Lord is my shepherd..."
- * The Catholic Church celebrates King David's Feast Day on December 29th
- * King David is an extremely advanced spiritual Entity; because of this, he does not incorporate on a regular basis

Dom Inácio (St. Ignatius of Loyola 1491-1556)

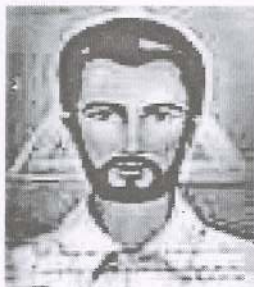


- * Principle Entity for whom the Casa is named (Casa de Dom Inácio)
- * Spanish Knight from a noble family, priest, theologian, hermit and true mystic
- * Faced hardship, persecution and incarceration during his lifetime in Spain (Spanish Inquisition)
- * Underwent a spiritual conversion while recovering from a near fatal leg wound received when a cannon ball shattered his leg in the Battle of Pamplona (1521)
- * During this time he read a series of religious texts on the life of Jesus and on the life and paths of the saints. He was transformed by an experience of spiritual consolation that God's love is freely given. He soon embarked upon a life of poverty, corporal and spiritual penance.
- * After experiencing a vision of the Mother Mary, he made a pilgrimage to her shrine at Montserrat (near Barcelona), put down his sword ~ then surrendered and dedicated his life to God
- * Founded the order known as the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) as directed in visions
- * Canonized in 1622 and is the Patron Saint of Soldiers
- * His Feast Day is on July 31st
- * He always incorporates at the Casa on the anniversary of his death which is also July 31st
- * Known for his unlimited compassion, kindness, patience and utmost dedication
- * While incorporating St. Ignatius, the body of Medium João seems bigger, his eyes look larger, and he appears to have more hair and walks with a limp

Dr. Augusto de Almeida (Unknown-1908)



- * One of the most frequently incorporated Entities
- * Performs many of the surgeries at the Casa
- * He is said to have been in the military, a surgeon, and a rubber tapper in previous incarnations
- * Worked as a gold miner in his last incarnation
- * Was a physician and surgeon before the development of anesthesia and saw much suffering
- * He is dedicated to alleviating pain and suffering
- * Can be very serious about his work with a strong personality and authoritative manner
- * Does not like to be interrupted as he works
- * Expects order and respect
- * Although often strict, he is incredibly gentle, loving and gracious
- * He is the one who reaches to the very depths of the abyss to save a soul
- * States often that he is not working as one individual but with a phalange of thousands
- * When Dr. Augusto is incorporated, Medium João's hair looks slightly darker and he stands tall and thinner

Dr. Oswaldo Cruz (1872-1917)



- *Regularly incorporates but rarely announces himself by name
- *Noted physician, bacteriologist and epidemiologist (one who studies the patterns, causes and effects of health and disease in defined populations)
- *Began his studies at the Faculty of Medicine in Rio de Janeiro at the age of 14. He studied and specialized in bacteriology at the Pasteur Institute in Paris and graduated from medical school at the age of 19.
- *Founded the Scientific Institution for Research and Development in Biomedical Sciences now known as the Oswaldo Cruz Institute in Rio de Janeiro. This institute produced vaccines against the bubonic plague, yellow fever and smallpox.
- *Instrumental in initiating sanitary campaigns throughout Brazil during many outbreaks and epidemics which saved thousands of lives
- *Honorary Mayor of the city of Petropolis, Rio de Janeiro in 1916 and key figure in the founding of Brasilia
- *Appointed Director General of Public Health in 1903
- *Awarded with a Gold Medal for his sanitation achievements in 1907
- *Retired as Minister of Health in 1909
- *Although often direct and forthright, he is very kind and compassionate
- *When he incorporates one can't help notice his beautiful eyes which seem to send out unconditional love to all those he glances upon. When Dr. Cruz incorporates he asks people to remove their watches as it disturbs his current of energy.

Dr. José Valdivino



- * Some believe that he was a legal judge, doctor and surgeon in past lives
- * His energy is especially powerful for healing paraplegics
- * Many miraculous healings have been recorded when Dr. Valdivino has commanded a paraplegic to walk or move their affected limbs
- * Crutches and wheelchairs have been discarded on the spot when he is present
- * Healings occur with just a command and touch of his hand
- * Exceptionally fond of Mother Mary
- * Refers to himself as "protector of families" and is helpful in dealing with family issues
- * Extremely gentle, overly compassionate and very considerate towards everyone he treats
- * His soft and loving energy changes the energy of others through Love
- * Encourages us to cleanse the soul through a "constant state of prayer" by forgiving others and asking to be forgiven
- * Cautions us to never expect love in return, give because you want to give
- * There is a photograph in the Surgery Room of the Casa where one can see the Entity so fully incorporated that Medium João's physical body is almost completely replaced by Dr. José Valdivino
- * Some think that it is Dr. Valdivino who is incorporated when Medium João chews on the tip of his ballpoint pen when writing prescriptions. This is a trait many have noticed that Dr. Valdivino does when contemplating.

Sister Sheila



- * Born in Germany
- * Dedicated nurse during World War II
- * Tirelessly helped the German victims during that time
- * She died in an air raid near the end of the war
- * One of the many female spirits diligently working in the background to support all types of healing and aftercare
- * The spiritual work of the Entity called, "Sister Sheila" consists of assisting the Entities in treating all those who are healing with love, mercy and grace
- * Acquires all the medical smarts of a doctor
- * Knows exactly what to do, what is most important and where the greatest need is
- * Courageous, hardworking and overly compassionate and understanding
- * Hopeful when all hope seems lost
- * Her energy is soft and feminine and her presence is accompanied by a specific floral fragrance
- * Some believe that she was Jeanne-Francoise Frémont in a previous incarnation who was born in France, dedicated her life to social aid and was canonized in 1767 as Saint Jeanne de Chantal (Jane Frances de Chantal). This Roman Catholic Saint who founded a religious order after the death of her husband is known as the Patron Saint of forgotten people, in-law problems, loss of parents, parents separated from children and widows. Her Feast Day is August 12th.

Not able to incorporate as an Entity but very able to participate.

Joan of Arc (1412-1431)



- * Born in a northeastern village of France to a devoutly religious peasant family
- * Nicknamed, "The Maid of Orleans"
- * She possessed many characteristics common to her contemporary female visionaries, who were a notable feature of her time: extreme piety, claims of direct communication with the saints, and a reliance on individual experience, as opposed to that found through the institutions of the Church, of the presence of God
- * As history would prove, beyond these traits, she also possessed remarkable mental and physical courage
- * At the age of 12 she heard the voices of St. Michael, St. Catherine and St. Margaret instructing her to support Charles VII and recover France from English dominion
- * Martyr, saint and military leader, Joan of Arc (age 18), acting under divine guidance, led the French army to victory over the British during the Hundred Years War
- * Captured a year later, Joan was burned at the stake by the English and their French collaborators as a heretic. She was only 19 years old.
- * 25 years after her execution, an inquisitorial court authorized by Pope Callixtus III examined the trial, debunked the charges against her, pronounced her innocent, and declared her a martyr
- * She was canonized as a Roman Catholic Saint 500 years later and is the Patroness of Soldiers and France. Her feast day is May 30th.
- * She became the greatest national heroine of her compatriots. Her achievement was a decisive factor in the later awakening of French national consciousness.

Dr. Bezerra de Menezes (1831-1900)



- * Respected doctor and surgeon
- * Took great pride in his role as a doctor and took his ethical responsibilities quite seriously
- * Treated many poor people, had no set fee for his services and never turned anyone away
- * Renowned for his charitable works and often called, "The Doctor of the Poor"
- * He himself had to endure periods of material poverty
- * Author of many spiritual books, a journalist, politician, monk, teacher, businessman and a great proponent of Brazilian Spiritism
- * Received a Catholic Baptism but later in life converted to Spiritualism after reading, "The Spirits' Book" by Allan Kardec
- * President of the Brazilian Spiritists Federation
- * Worked on spreading the "Good News" that death does not exist but is a transition from the material world into the spirit world

"A doctor is not entitled to finish a meal, nor to ask if it is far or near, when an afflicted person knocks on the door. Those who do not help because they are entertaining guests or worked long hours and are tired, or because it is too late at night and bad weather, because it is far or on top of a hill, or above all, those who have not even resources to pay or to say to those that are crying at their door to seek for another doctor – those are not doctors, but rather medicine doctors, who work for the income and to pay off their college debts."

Dr. José Penteado



- * Not much is known about him
- * Many believe he was a member of the Jesuits (Society of Jesus)
- * Doctor
- * Powerful, stable and strong energy
- * Always works at the side of people with humility and respect
- * His energy is truly loving and he is very kind and patient
- * Some say that this Entity is very willing to explain what is being done which many find helpful
- * Takes his time
- * He loves fruit and often a staff person will place a glass of fresh orange juice on the table next to Medium João for this Entity to drink while he is incorporated

St. Rita of Cascia (1381-1457)



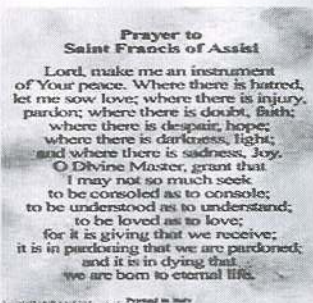
Legend has it that Rita would regularly bring food to the poor, which her husband prohibited her from doing. One day, her husband confronted her as she was leaving to bring bread to the poor. The bread was concealed in Rita's robes; when she uncovered the bread as her husband demanded, the bread became roses and Rita was spared her husband's wrath.

At the end of her life, when Rita was bedridden in a convent, a visiting friend asked if there was anything Rita wanted. Rita replied that she would like a rose from the garden. It was January and this seemed like an impossible request but the friend went to look and discovered a single brightly colored blossom on the bush. The rose is thought to represent God's love for Rita and her ability to intercede on behalf of lost causes or impossible cases.

- * Born of devout Catholic parents in the small village of Roccaporena, Italy as Rita Lotti
- * With her one desire to be of service to God, she often visited the convent of the Augustinian Nuns in Cascia with hopes of joining their community
- * Her parents had other plans for her future. They arranged for her to marry a man they believed would provide her with security and happiness but her husband proved to be ill tempered and abusive. Prayer and patience lled her days as she endured a difficult life. After the death of her husband and two sons, she returned to the convent in Cascia and convinced the nuns to accept her into their order.
- * Her meditations and prayers showed a singular devotion to the suffering that Jesus endured on the cross. One day as she prayed, a wound appeared on her forehead where the crown of thorns would have laid. It is said that the stigmata stayed with her for fifteen years.
- * Beatified in 1626 by Pope Urban VIII and Canonized by Pope Leo XIII in 1900. She is Brazil's Patron Saint of Miracles. Others refer to her as the Patron Saint of Desperate Cases and the Saint of the Impossible. She is worshipped by those who bear exceptionally heavy burdens in their life, most notably women.
- * The symbol most often associated with St. Rita is the rose. Many often smell roses when they sit in meditation at the Casa. Her energy is a mixture of strength, gentleness, love and support. On her Feast Day of May 22nd, churches and shrines of St. Rita provide their congregations with roses that are blessed by priests during the mass.
- * It was St. Rita who appeared to a young João Teixeira de Faria inspiring him to engage in a lifelong service to God. Since Medium João does not incorporate female Entities, she works in the background assisting and lending her loving presence and devotion.

St. Francis of Assisi (1181-1226)



- * Son of a wealthy cloth merchant, he was born Giovanni di Pietro di Bernardone but nicknamed Francesco (The Frenchman) by his father who wanted a man of business, not a man of God
- * He abandoned a life of luxury and that typical of a wealthy young man for a life of poverty and one devoted to Christianity after reportedly hearing the voice of God, who commanded him to rebuild the Christian Church
- * Though he was never ordained to the Catholic Priesthood, St. Francis is one of the most venerated religious figures in history. He founded, The Men's Order of Friar's Minor, The Women's Order of St. Clare and The Third Order for Brothers and Sisters of Penance.
- * Many of the stories that surround the life of St. Francis deal with his love for animals. He believed that nature itself was the mirror of God. He called all creatures his brothers and sisters. The animals loved him because of his pure heart.
- * He loved people as well and practiced true equality by showing honor, respect and love to every person whether they were beggar or pope
- * He is also known for his love of the Eucharist, his sorrow during the Stations of the Cross and for the creation of the Christmas Nativity Scene
- * In 1224, he received the stigmata, making him the first person to bear the wounds of Christ
- * In 1228, he was proclaimed a saint by Pope Gregory IX. He is known as the Patron Saint of Animals and the Environment. His Feast Day is October 4th.
- * Viewed as one of the greatest examples of how to live the Christian ideal since Jesus Christ himself

- * Experienced deep inner reflection desiring to know where God dwells
- * Valued the importance of staying connected to Source
- * Known to be very fond of Mother Mary
- * Admired the Divine Feminine Energy
- * Learned to walk the path of power and not to suppress it
- * Understood that human power is very limited and that the true power of energy resides in our hearts
- * Love opens hearts ~ open hearts lead to healing
- * Shares with us a universal wisdom and spiritual knowledge of healing
- * Assists us in taking control of our lives to live better and to make the necessary changes towards our own inner happiness

Allan Kardec (1804-1896)



- * Pen name of the French teacher and educator Hippolyte Leon Denizard Rivail
- * Known as the Systematizer of Spiritism for which he laid the foundation with the Five Books of the Spiritist Codification
- * Spent his early life in the academic pursuits of science, medicine and the classics but his interests soon focused on the supernatural phenomenon of spirit communication
- * Began working with renowned mediums and channelers in an attempt to scientifically record such phenomena
- * His research findings were published in the French text, Le Livre des Esprits (explaining the relationship between the spiritual and material worlds)
- * Kardec believed that all authoritative institutions, science and all organized religion, were incapable of objective studies of paranormal phenomena because both were too steeped in dogma
- * He believed that the soul is eternal and evolves through a series of incarnations in the material world to learn and progress spiritually and that there were two worlds, visible and invisible
- * His intention was to understand the relationship between the physical and nonphysical worlds based solely on spiritual discernment
- * This research formed the basis of the Spiritist Doctrine ~ the belief that only direct communication with the spirit world provides objective answers to the question of how to live a moral and ethical life
- * Spiritists believe that because these spirits are also involved in a journey to attain higher and purer realms of consciousness, they freely offer us the lessons they have learned to assist us in our individual and collective spiritual progress

St. Francis Xavier (1506-1552)



- * Born Francisco de Jasso y Azpilicuet
- * Born of nobility
- * Roman Catholic Missionary born in Xavier (now a part of Spain)
- * Considered to be one of the greatest missionaries since St. Paul
- * Studied in Paris and taught philosophy at Beauvais College where he met Ignatius of Loyola
- * Co-founder of the Jesuits (Society of Jesus)
- * One of the first seven Jesuits who took vows of poverty and chastity at Montmartre (Paris)
- * Influential in evangelization work most notably in India and other areas that had not yet been visited by Christian Missionaries
- * Ministered to people who suffered spiritual and physical hardships
- * Beatified by Paul V and canonized by Gregory XV (at the same time as Ignatius Loyola)
- * Pius XI proclaimed him the "Patron Saint of Catholic Missions" (Feast Day~December 3rd)
- * As an Entity of the Casa he has been known to take crutches away from people who then walk freely on their own. He has lifted a wheelchair bound person and invited him to walk out of the room.
- * Many talk about how he comes down the line personally addressing people with messages of healing
- * He often shares stories of miraculous healings he once performed when he was in the physical

Dr. André Luiz



- * The Entity, Dr. André Luiz dictated information through automatic writing from the spiritual realms to Francisco Cândido (Chico) Xavier
- * He partnered with Chico Xavier and acted as a reporter on conditions in the spirit world, revealing details of its life, people, places and organization. The study of Spiritism would not be the same without the literary gifts of André Luiz and his medium, Chico Xavier
- * Today, Spiritists know this spirit author as a magnificent messenger, teacher and friend, one who is greatly admired and honored for his literary contributions to the advancement in mankind's understanding of spirit matters
- * "Nosso Lar" was the first book in a series of novels that would literally catalyze the Spiritist Movement, awakening readers to the tangibility of spirit life and the interaction that exists between the spiritual and material worlds
- * Much of the information relayed throughout these books was based on his own after death experiences and his struggles to understand his new reality. A true skeptic at the time of his demise, he was shocked at the discovery that death is nothing more than a doorway to a new and richer life. As time progresses, he undergoes inevitable experiences and teachings in the spirit realm which lead him to a better understanding of life's meaning.
- * Before transitioning to the spirit world, André Luiz was a practicing medical doctor in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil during the early twentieth century
- * There is a movie titled, "Astral City, A Spiritual Journey" which is about the life of the doctor, André Luiz in the spiritual city of Nosso Lar

Euripedes Barsanulfo (1880-1918)



- * Journalist, politician, educator, pharmacist and Spiritist Medium
- * He co-founded a primary and secondary school in his hometown of Sacramento, Brazil
- * Developed a reputation as a compassionate and dedicated teacher
- * Brought up to be a devoted Catholic and to follow the teachings of Jesus
- * Became fascinated with the writings and teachings of Allen Kardec
- * Headed the Spiritist Center for over a decade
- * Founded the Allen Kardec College in Brazil
- * Teaching Spiritualism brought him great joy
- * Enjoyed bringing expansion into the constriction of certain belief systems
- * His healing and mediumistic abilities were internationally known
- * Worked tirelessly throughout the Spanish Influenza Epidemic helping thousands
- * Devoted his life to service
- * It is said that Euripedes always announces himself when he incorporates
- * He prefers to do "invisible" operations
- * His energy is described as being extremely strong and enthusiastic
- * Many feel increased lightness and much joy when he is present

Francisco (Chico) Cândido Xavier (1910-2002)



- * Chico Xavier, born Francisco de Paula Cândido was a popular medium and philanthropist of Brazil's Spiritism Movement
- * One of the most prolific twentieth-century writers in Brazil's Kardecist Spiritist Movement
- * Noted for his paranormal abilities as a medium and the technique referred to as psychography (channeling a spirit in order to write a book based on the knowledge imparted by the spirit)
- * He has channeled over 400 books that cover a wide range of subjects
- * His books have sold over 25 million copies and all profits are donated to charity
- * Chico is most known for the works he produced in collaboration with two of his guides: Emmanuel (a highly advanced being who shares his vision of a new form of Christianity) and André Luiz (a physician and poet who commented on the nature of life after death)
- * These books are most helpful if you intend to visit the Casa
- * He dedicated his life to Jesus, was an avid humanitarian and devoted his psychic abilities to reassure others that life continues after death
- * During his two day wake it is estimated that approximately 2500 people per hour paid tribute to him as they filed past his coffin. Many in attendance were Brazilian, Islamic, Jewish and Christian World Leaders.
- * He was both a mentor and cherished friend to João Teixeira de Faria. João, who dearly loved him was a pallbearer at his funeral.
- * He channeled a message from Dr. Bezerra Menezes which led João to establish the Casa in Abadiânia in 1978

Emmanuel



- * The enlightened being known as Emmanuel was Chico Xavier's spiritual guide, mentor and advisor
- * According to Chico, Emmanuel lived as Senator Publius Lentulus (stepfather of Mark Antony and contemporary of Julius Caesar) during Roman times
- * Another one of his many incarnations was that of the Portuguese Jesuit Priest, Manuel da Nóbrega. Nóbrega was the first Provincial of the Society of Jesus in Colonial Brazil. He was very influential and helped with the founding of several cities such as Rio de Janeiro and São Paulo. His missionary work consisted of the development and building of churches, Jesuit Colleges, schools and seminaries.
- * Emmanuel is also reported by Chico Xavier to have had a life as a professor at the Sorbonne (an edifice of the Latin Quarter, in Paris, France, which was the historical house of the former University of Paris)
- * Emmanuel does not often announce himself, but he is one of the Entities who incorporates through Medium João
- * When Emmanuel first appeared to Chico, he asked Chico if he was ready for the task. Chico's reply was affirmative. Emmanuel promised never to abandon him and gave Chico three rules to follow on his spiritual mission:

1. Discipline 2. Discipline 3. Discipline
